Bobcat Badge

Before earning any other



Badge every Scout must earn his Bobcat Badge. There are eight things that a Scout must learn to earn his Bobcat Badge. These items are Cub Scout Promise, Law of the Pack, Tell What Webelos Mean, Cub Scout Sign, Cub Scout Handshake, Cub Scout Motto, Cub Scout Salute, and the Bobcat Requirements in the front of the book with a Parent.

Tiger Badge

Tiger Cubs earn the



Tiger Cub Totem when he learns the Tiger Cub motto, Cub Scout sign, and Cub Scout salute. This is a plastic tiger paw with space for four strands for totem beads that he wears on his right pocket. A boy earns totem beads by working on the five Tiger Cub achievements. Each achievement has three parts. The boy earns a white bead for each required family activity; an orange bead for each required den activity; and a black bead for each required Go See It activity. The boy then earns the Tiger Cub Badge when he has completed all 15 parts of the five achievements. After earning his Tiger Badge, a Tiger Cub may start receiving his **Tiger Track Beads**. For every 10 electives that are

completed the Tiger Cub earns 1 Tiger Track Bead.

After completing the requirements for the Bear Badge, Bear Scouts can earn gold and silver arrow points by completing additional requirements.

Webelos earn Activity Pins by completing a certain number of requirements in a particular category such as artist or naturalist. Webelos must earn certain activity badges in order to earn their Webelos Badge, Compass Points and the Arrow of Light. The colors are the red, yellow, and green ribbons worn on the right shoulder of the Webelos uniform.

Outdoor Activities With your den, pack, or family:

Participate in a nature hike in your local area. This can be on an organized, marked trail, or just a hike to observe nature in your area.

Explain the buddy system and tell what to do if lost. Explain the importance of cooperation.

Attend a pack overnigher. Be responsible by being prepared for the event.

Complete an outdoor service project in your community. Complete a nature/conservation project in your area. This project should involve improving, beautifying, or supporting natural habitats. Discuss how this project helped you to respect nature.
